



# Explanatory Note – the College’s Public Register

## The Public Register

Pursuant to section 33 of the *Health Professions Act* (HPA), the Alberta College of Medical Diagnostic and Therapeutic Technologists (ACMDTT) is required to maintain a public register of all regulated members. The College is also maintaining a public register of non-regulated members. The information contained within the register includes full name, practice name, registration type, registration status, conduct history, join date, effective and expiry date, member’s registration number, specialty, restrictions and conditions, authorization and enhancement.

## Searching the Public Register

The public register can be accessed through the College’s website - <https://acmdtt.com/> by clicking on the icon titled “Public Register.”

The public can search for Medical Radiation Technologists (MRTs) and Electroneurophysiology Technologists (ENPs) by the last name and/or member’s registration number.

## Contents of the Public Register

The HPA and the ACMDTT’s bylaws set out the information that is required to be contained on the public register regarding regulated and non-regulated members of the College. This document summarizes the information that can be found on the registry regarding MRTs and ENPs in Alberta.

## MRTs and ENPs

### Summary

This section contains basic identifying information about MRTs and ENPs, including:

Full Name	This section identifies the first and last names of the MRT or ENP as registered by the College.	
Practice Name	The name that the MRT or ENP identifies with in their practice.	
Registration Type	This section identifies a member’s current registration type with the College. There are currently different registration types, which are as follows:	
	• General	A regulated member of the College in the general register and the member is currently practising the profession.
	• Temporary	A regulated member of the College in the temporary register and the member is currently practising the profession that they must receive supervision when performing restricted activities.
	• Courtesy	A regulated member of the College in the Courtesy register and the member is currently practising the profession usually for a maximum of six months.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Associate</li> </ul>	A non-regulated member of the College in the associate register and is not practising the profession.
Registration Status	This identifies the status of a regulated and non-regulated member at any point in time in their registration with the College.	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Active</li> </ul>	A regulated or non-regulated member of the College, who is in good standing.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Suspended (Administrative)</li> </ul>	A regulated member who has had their practice permit temporarily suspended for administrative reasons, which may include failure to complete renewal, non-payment of registration fees, Continuing Competence Program (CCP) non-compliant or lack of professional liability insurance. The member is not entitled to practice while their practice permit is suspended.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Suspended</li> </ul>	The regulated member is not entitled to practice while their practice permit is suspended.
	Suspended Sexual Abuse	A regulated member who has had their practice permit suspended due to sexual abuse.
	Suspended Sexual Misconduct	A regulated member who has had their practice permit suspended due to sexual misconduct.
	Suspended Unprofessional Conduct	A regulated member who has had their practice permit suspended due to unprofessional conduct.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cancelled (Administrative)</li> </ul>	A regulated member who has had their practice permit cancelled for administrative reasons, which may include failure to complete renewal, Continuing Competence Program (CCP) non-compliant, non-payment of registration fees, or lack of professional liability insurance.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cancelled</li> </ul>	The regulated member is not entitled to practice while their practice permit is cancelled
	Cancelled Sexual Abuse	A regulated member who has had their practice permit cancelled due to sexual abuse.
	Cancelled Sexual Misconduct	A regulated member who has had their practice permit cancelled due to sexual misconduct.
	Cancelled Unprofessional Conduct	A regulated member who has had their practice permit cancelled due to unprofessional conduct.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Removed</li> </ul>	A regulated member who has had their practice permit removed due to administrative reasons, such as leaving the province, retirement, resignation, death or other reasons. The member is not entitled to practice while their practice permit is removed from the register.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Expired</li> </ul>	A non regulated member who has had their membership expired due to non-renewal.
Registration number	This section identifies the practice number the College assigns to all regulated and non-regulated members of the College. This number is specific to each member and cannot be duplicated.	
Conduct History	<p>This section includes a member’s conduct history, all orders of the College during an investigation, and also orders of the hearing tribunal pursuant of s.82(1) of the HPA. This includes, but not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cautions and specified continuing education or remediation programs ordered;</li> <li>Conditions imposed on the member’s practice permit;</li> <li>Information related to current and past hearing tribunal decisions related to unprofessional conduct;</li> <li>Information related to any known current criminal convictions, criminal charges and bail conditions including charges and convictions of sexual abuse and sexual misconduct;</li> <li>Findings of malpractice;</li> <li>Unprofessional conduct in another jurisdiction.</li> </ul>	
Join Date	This section includes the date the member initially registered with the College and was granted a practicing permit.	
Effective and Expiry Date	This section includes the date the member’s practice permit is effective, and the date it expires. This section does not identify registration year after year.	
Specialty	This section identifies the five specialties of the College, which include nuclear medicine, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance imaging, radiological technology and electroneurophysiology.	
Conditions and Restrictions	This section identifies conditions placed on a member, which may be administrative, or conduct related. These conditions include but not limited to supervision, practice permit limitations and/or regular reporting. This section also includes restrictions placed on a member’s practice permit.	
Additional and Enhanced Authorizations	This section identifies enhancements and/or authorizations granted by the College to a member who may provide a restricted activity that is not normally provided by regulated members. This includes, but not limited to, venipuncture, medical administration, breast and bladder ultrasound, etc.	

**Disclosure**

There are circumstances under which a regulated or non-regulated member of the College may not have the above information on the public register. For example, if the Registrar has reasonable grounds to believe that divulgence of the information could lead to safety concerns for the member, the Registrar will withhold the information as required.
